REPORT

Subject : Utilization by FECADE of received 2019 FIDE_PDC funds (annex 1).

Introduction

To begin with, it is worth to mention that all chess events listed on the Fecade's 2019 strategic plan were meant to be organized nationwide throughout our three chess regions.

In June 2019, the Minister of Sports and Physical Education directed all National Sports Federations to close their 2019 sport season by June, 23th. This was to align Cameroonian sport season with the one of "Confédération Africaine de Football" (CAF). As a consequence, events planned to be organized from June to December 2019 were cancelled.

Besides this instruction from Sports Ministry and on the same June 2019, we have been instructed by Fide to use funds received earlier for chess development to take a delegation of six persons to the All Africa Games at Casablanca, Morocco (see annex 2). Again this instruction of Fide came to set aside some events listed on the 2019 Fecade strategic plan presented to Fide on April 2019.

To make things more complicated for us, the Federation's bank has changed the Fecade's bank account number in the same June 2019, without informing the Federation. This malpractice of the bank lead to some ups and downs between Fide accounts and Fecade bank accounts, making it possible for Fecade to cash the money from Fide only on early July, to begin working for Fecade's participation into Moroccan All Africa Games.

For these three reasons coming at the same time from Ministry of Sports, Fide, and Federation bank, the utilization of received Fide funds did not necessarily follow the initial path and plan.

CONCLUSION :

To end with, all chess events to be organized with received Fide_PDC funds did not take place as planned, due to unexpected events presented above in introduction that are beyond our control.

However, given the conditions in which these funds have been used, we feel that we went far over from what was expected from us to do with these Fide_PDC funds : use the funds to take a delegation of four players, one Coach and one Head of delegation to the All Africa Games chess competition in Morocco.

In line with the utilization of Fide funds, we do propose that FIDE_PDC launch a study on how to fund federations that might have their sport season overlapping with two calendar years as it is now in Cameroon (from September year n to June year n+1), and not as it is now in Fide (from January year n to October year n).
