1. Bronze medal in the Pan American Chess Championship under 20, in the female branch, held in the month of August in the city of Cochabamba.

2. Massive participation of Bolivian athletes in the Pan-American Under 20 Chess Championship, due to the subsidies for a large part of the cost in accommodation and food.

3. All Bolivian athletes who participated in the Pan American Under 20 Chess Championship had the support of a coach.

4. Gold Medal at the Sub 08 Women's Pan American Chess Festival, Gold Medal at the Sub 12 Absolute South American Festival (BLITZ) and Silver Medal at the Absolute Sub 08 South American Festival (BLITZ)

5. Participation with 28 athletes in the South American Chess Festival

6. For the first time before the South American, the Bolivian champions have a training camp with all expenses paid.

7. Support with air tickets to all Bolivian Champions and the Trainer for the South American Chess Festival.

11. Summary of Project Outcomes:


