The Planning and Development Commission (https://pdc.fide.com) organized a federation management workshop. Marco Verdoia, who recently joined FIDE's marketing department, gave a brief speech in which he highlighted the importance of brand-building.

#### Why is it important to develop your brand?

- Increased internal and external engagement: A strong brand can drive your longterm strategic goals, increase public trust, increase internal cohesion, increase awareness about your activities and your work, build your reputation.
- 2) Standing out: Developing your brand will help you stand out amongst other sports organizations and get your message across in a noisy space.
- 3) Increased Trust and Loyalty: When a brand has been intentionally crafted, properly positioned and aligned to its target audiences, the trust and loyalty of the audience increase.
- 4) Increased opportunities to attract sponsors: In the sports industry, the competition for funding is high. A strong brand can help you attract more sponsors and achieve your fundraising goals by increasing visibility and credibility of your organizations and generating support.



The workshop also included some guidelines for how to pitch potential partners with an event sponsorship proposal.

#### Step 4: Determine sponsor compatibility

There are some questions you should answer to use when considering a potential sponsorship compatibility:

- Do we have an existing relationship or connection?
- · Are our marketing objectives similar enough?
- About how many events have they sponsored in the past?
- Are we evenly matched in terms of company and/or audience size?
- Are their business operations of a similar size (local versus international, etc.)?
- Do their key brand elements and values closely match ours?
- Do their primary competitors use event sponsorship to their advantage?
- Which sponsors provide the most opportunity for us to achieve our event objectives?



This project is FIDE's response to a serious issue: the lack of big data and global figures. The chess community needs to tackle this problem in order to access new sources of funding.




#### Update: February 27, 10:20 GMT



#### 13 – 15 July 2020

#### **Uzbekistan Chess Federation**

The 83rd Internet Based FIDE Arbiters' Seminar (UZB) was held from 13th to 15th July 2020 using the Zoom platform. It was organized by the Uzbekistan Chess Federation, under the auspices of FIDE and Asian Chess Federation.

The Lecturer was IA Husan Turdialiev (UZB), FIDE Lecturer and the Assistant Lecturer was IA Irina Gevorgyan (UZB). The Language of the Seminar was in Russian. The Seminar took 18 hours in three days.

The Seminar was prepared mainly for the Russian speaking participants from Zone 3.4 FIDE countries - Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan. Due to the increasing interest in such a Seminar we also received applications from other countries, and they also were allowed to participate. Therefore sixteen arbiters from seven Federations (Belarus, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Lithuania, Tajikistan, Ukraine and Uzbekistan) participated in the Seminar and fifteen of them participated in the examination test, held after the end of the lectures.
