2. REPORTS OF NOT APPROVED OR NOT COMPLETED

A- Online Arbiter Seminar

The Online Arbiter Seminar was approved by PDC on October 22nd and there were problems to confirm the lecturer to do it still on 2020 . IA Sabrina San Vicente was going to be the assistant but the lectures in English were not possible to find with the budgeted per hour to the lecturer

There are few lectures english speaking in America for FA/IA Seminars. Since the Online Seminar would be focused on Caribe the presence of English speaking lecture was of utmost importance. CCA to give back to FIDE the ammount received or if FIDE prefers to revert to 2021 Seminar

B- Online Educational Seminar/Panel

The Online Educational Seminar/Panel was not approved on October 22 2020 by Educational Commission (the rules of the cooperation between FIDE and the Continents though the anual plan determined by FIDE demands that each project should be signed by the relevant comission) but we were not informed why it was not approved. We had some meetings with Educational Commission by zoom prior to submission of the request. We even sent our Educacional plan of CCA to EDU . We hope in the future to have a better understanding of EDU needs to be able to make it possible fruitfull projects.

C- Online Trainer Seminar

The Online Trainer Seminar was approved on October 22 2020 by Trainer's Commission and PDC (the rules of the cooperation between FIDE and the Continents though the anual plan determined by FIDE demands that each project should be signed by the relevant comission) Here we want to thank Peter Long the Commission secretary for all the help given. There was a guideline from to charge the participants that would not receive a Grant. Since we wanted to have it Federations level 4 and 5 it would not fit what CCA have planned. We understood FIDE TRG policy but he TRG Seminar was done planned to be free of charge for the participants. So we plan a different trainer Seminar for 2021 following the guidelines.

2020 GA America Report

Mexico City, November 2nd, 2020.

Dear All,

Since the last GA held at Abu Dhabi the virus has hit very hard the America continent becoming it a contagious and deaths hot spot, hence we take the decision of postponing all over-the-board events to 2021 year in order to assure players and officials health and due to the closing of borders and quarantines established by the nations. I do not expect their resumption until the 2Q next year.

In the meantime, and following FIDE guidelines we organize different kinds of online activities such as tournaments and technical seminars and training groups to keep chess spirit alive.

CCA finances have been hit hard with no income from entry fees or sponsorship , we have covered the fixed expenses form our reserves but now they are running out.

I am very worried about the events of the Cycle, no Zonals or Continental has been organized this year and what is worse there will be no money to cover prizes, the potential venues can cover the administrative expenses of the tournamets but nothing else and governments will not grant a penny for them as well as potential sponsors which are more worried to survive themselves.

I shall speak about this matter when Emil will deal with the Cycle in the GA, and shall clarify any questions they may be asked for.

I apologize for being so short.
