INTRODUTION

The objective of this Report is to inform the International Chess Federation - FIDE, our activities for 2020 and how the funds provided to **A**ngola **C**hess **F**ederation, for Chess Development, were applied.

The Angola Chess Federation is pleased to release its annual report for the year ended 2020.

The world suffered an epidemic Covid 19 which put over the board activities into disarray. The World Health Organisation declared that all human interactions be minimal to avert spreading the virus through human crowding.

We were all made to sanitise our hands and wear masks at all times apart other messurements.

FAX had planned a number of activities over the board including our traditional event **Angola Open** in November. As if that was not enough we lost our best Player **IM Aderito Pedro**. His death was felt world wide with condolences pouring in from all corners of the world.

To honour our best Player,

During the Covid lockdown we did participate in a number of online events namely Arbiters seminar and Trainers. Our countrymen participated and attained Fide Qualifications.

We played a 10 board match against Cape Verde thanks to good cooperation between both Portuguese speaking Countries.

So, investments in telecommunications and informatics, and online chess board was actually the first priority and we established as one of our objectives, participation on Tournaments online participate on ACC/fide tournaments and training courses online

Angola Chess Federation hosted a series of online chess tournaments under the theme "Stay Home playing Chess" and also actively participated on the project "Checkmate Corona Virus" in June and July 2020.

The project was joined by hundreds of people from all parts of the country. With the help of Provincial Associations and many chess enthusiasts we managed to host numerous official events in terms of participation including a 24Hour marathon.

As a mark for the year, we proudly won the **2020 Zone 4.5 online Chess Champions** with a young promising team for honoring the memory of our best player **IM Adérito Pedro** by taking the bacon home.

During the pandemic period we organized regular tournaments as follows: Tuesdays and Fridays Free Heatings 19:00 - 21:30 Wednesday and Saturdays Aquecimento com Gracinhas 16:00 – 17:30 Valendo Saldinhos 19:00 – 20:30



Sundays Free Heating Arena from 10:00 – 19:00 Valendo Saldinhos 19:00 -20:30 Team Matches 21:00 – 23:00 Weekly Main Tournament Saturday 19:00 -21:30

We are very proud, and thankful for the response of the chess community to this project. For example after Checkmate Coronavirus project was over, we've got many comments and letters from chess community asking to continue this initiative.

The above activities gave us experience and power that contributed a lot on achievement of the good performance on the online chess championchips as follows: Luzia Pires qualified to the 2nd fase of the World Junior Championship Lionel Soares Jemima Paulo

The year was also marked with board elections which were won by Eng Tito Martins and his Team. And while we are getting ready for a new season, we are very active on Social media.

Investment in online chess

The challenge worldwide of actual pandemic disease remind everybody to change the strategy and invest a little bit more in online chess, considering the particularity and advantage of chess allow our game to be played online. So, investments in telecommunications and informatics, and online chess board was one of our priorities during last year.

We created basic conditions to entertain players and be able to participate on ACC/Fide tournaments and training courses online.

Chess in school program

- > Improve children's educational outcomes and foster their social development by introducing them to the game of chess in schools and inner-city communities.
- > Organize and promote national chess events as a catalyst for mass participation.
- > Raise the profile of chess and highlight its educational and social benefits.
- > Increase the number of chess players and teachers

Still being a big challenge the gradual implementation of chess in schools' programs sucessfuly with all Schools closed due to pandemic conditions we invested on the building up fututure conditions and support, gain the necessary knowledge of chess teacher and acquisition of chess material as Chess pieces, borders, books, electronic material and others.

As we all knows this project was deeply affected because the Schools were suspended) Before the schools closed, we registerd 24 Schools with chess programes, 62 School teachers, and around 1500 Students were engaged in chess in school programmes

Junior and Youth National Teams

We appreciated the format used on the Online Olympiad as it allowed us to give opportunities to our young teams to play at high level.



After a closer look at our good performance at the torurnament, we foun out that main support was in the Youth and Ladies Categories.

Those results encourage us to continue working on those categories due to our main goal, achieve a GM Title.

Capacity Building Technical Area

The Angolan Chess federation planned to improve knowledge of our trainers, arbiters and leaders for fide events, giving them some opportunities to participate in seminars and judge as much tournaments as possible, in Angola or abroad: we mobilized 30 new trainers to participate on online seminars and worked hard to have at least 5 new certificated training seminars around Angola for new certificated arbiters.

Women In Chess Program

Considering the empowerment of women in chess events, as chief arbiters, directorate and trainers, we have planned the permanent improvement of their knowledge and increase the women in chess activities, because we are as Federation need create much more opportunities and motivate women to proceed in chess career. Therefore, we are glad to inform that along the Trainer seminar that was organized last year a WCM Finished successfully the training and will work on chess development.

Activities For Disabled People

This is a new challenge of Fide and federations worldwide, so after our presence in the first world championship for disabled we in Angola have started the process to work harder on this category to prepare a team in good shape for the future commitment: Prepare a national disabled team with six players at categories of hearing impairment, physical disability and visual impairment.

Marketing and Publicity

Although, last year the Covid 19 created problems to everyone, we were able to mobilise new Sponsors and consolidate the existing but unfortunately we lost some to the crisis. During the year Chess was active on Social Media with at least 76 positive or neutral articles.

Social activities

Due to recent past of Angola civil war and its consequences we have a number of children in the streets and is prisons, Angolan Chess Federation have given some finace condition to the internal commission for chess street and chess in prison. This commission organized training events and philanthropic events with Street People, with Female Players and made contracts to create conditions to start work with People in prisons. In that spirit we have availed at least 150 chess boards to assist in practice sessions of chess at children in the street and people in prison, with objective in improve the relationship with our strategic partners, consolidate the relationship with our sponsors and gain new ones)

Angola Chess Activities of 2020

The Angola Chess Federation is an institution regulated by Angolan law and sponsored by Angola Sport Ministry, whose main purpose is to promote, to incentive, regulate and organize the practices and



development of chess in all Angolan territory. In line with its mission, FAX has 18 provinces under its control, supporting the cost of all the national competitions, Africans and World Championships cycles we have been playing, and most events related of Angolan chess development we participate or organize. So, considering our planned activities for 2020, the amount submitted above, as fide support, represents almost 18% of provisional costs of Angola Chess Federation in 2020 and will be very grateful to have this found to help us implement the Chess Development Plan of 2020, with certain success. **(KPI;** increase the number of players in the fide list to 1000, organize at least three international tournaments, for norm of GM and WGM**)**

As the reigning 2020 Zone 4.5 online Chess Champions we salute our team for honouring the memory of our best player by taking the bacon home.
