**KEY PERFORMANCE INDICATORS (KPIs)** <sup>1</sup> are the critical (key) indicators of progress toward an intended result.

The NCF is required to measure the effectiveness of its programmes using the KPIs listed below. At the beginning of the period, the NCF is expected to complete both the **Baseline** and **End of Period-target** values. It is possible that a Federation may not be able to report on a particular KPI and this will be taken into consideration at the end of the reporting period. NCFs can also make use of the '**Comments**' field as required. The NCF is also allowed to include any additional KPIs that it considers to be relevant for reporting purposes. When the NCF is preparing its final report for the end of the reporting period, the **Actual** values of the KPIs need to be completed for each KPI identified.

#### **KPI STRUCTURE**

The KPIs' shall be divided into 4 main categories as follows:

**Core:** These KPIs are related to the technical operations of the federation. It includes number of active players, number of tournaments, average player ratings as well as supporting 'infrastructure' e.g. number of arbiters, trainers ETC. Most of this information can be sourced from by FIDE via its website or from the Elista office. This KPI allows FIDE to ascertain the quality/quantity of the players, technical officials events, etc...

**Social/Special:** These examine the engagement in additional programmes related to the work of other FIDE Commissions and their priorities. These include: females, kids/chess in education, vulnerable groups (refugees, people with special needs, chess in prisons etc.). Federations are encouraged to engage in at least one such programme. This KPI allows federations to fulfil the horizontal goals of FIDE as chess impacts several aspects of society.

**Promotion:** This includes the focus on the dissemination and profiling of chess activities of the federation and FIDE support. This should include mainstream and social media. It is important that chess activities are highlighted so persons within the wider communities understand the value of chess and the role of FIDE which can increase the opportunities for support.

**Partnerships:** This includes sponsors, strategic partners whose objectives are aligned to the federation. Strategic partners can include other government agencies, NGOS, media outlets. This KPI tracks the efforts of federations to engage other partners in the support of their mandate so as to build increased sustainability.

Of course, Federations can also include any other KPIs they see as relevant to their operations. The KPIs are listed in the table below.

# **HISTORY**

The Cape Verdean Chess Federation (FCX) was founded on April 17, 2016. On 11 September of the same year, at a General Assembly held in Baku, he was accepted as a member of FIDE.

In June 2017, FCX held its first



First National Championships (Rapid and Blitz) - June 2017

official competitions: National Rapid Championships (individual and team) and the National Blitz Championship (individual and team), homologated by FIDE.

The main chess event in Cape Verde, the National Championship of Individual Absolutes (CNIA), had its first edition in 2017, held on the island of Sal in September.

In the tournament participated 6 players: the best ranking of the season and the 5 regional champions who, in a tournament of Round Robin, were the first Absolute National Champion.

It was soon known that this model was not right, because in some

regions its champions had a much lower playing power than those ranked in the more modest places of other regional.

Thus, in CNIA 2018, the model adopted was the realization of a preliminary, open to all players, but limited in the

number of participants. For this

preliminary, they had their place

reserved for regional champions and national champions of youth. The top three finishers in this preliminary, the 2017 National Champion and the top 2 in the national rankings in July 2018, on the island of S. Vicente, in a round robin tournament, competed in the second edition of the CNIA, with the attraction of being this competition that would determine the players who would be part of the team on the 43rd. Olympic Games in Batumi.

In 2019, the model remained with the only change that 2 players were added to the final, one chosen by the organizer and the other by FCX. Thus, in December, on the island of S. Nicolau, the third edition of the CNIA was played in the round system with 8 players.

In 2020, with the covid-19 apémia, FCX was the only sports federation in Cape Verde to risk the most important race. With strict health security measures, the fourth edition of the CNIA was held, due to the pandemic, with limited vacancies, some of which are reserved: regional representatives, the Champion of the previous season and the best

national classifications. The competition took place on the island of S. Vicente in October.

# V ABSOLUTE INDIVIDUAL NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP 2021

For the fifth edition of the CNIA, it was decided to return to the preliminary and final regime.

For the final will be determined the Champion of the previous season, the winner of the Cape Verde Cup, competition instituted in 2021 to encourage the resumption, at regional level, of the 3 best national qualifications and the 3 or 5 best qualifications, depending on whether or not there is external support for the realization of Cnia 2021.

## **PRELIMINARY PHASE**

The preliminary phase of CNIA 2021 took place on September 24, 25 and 26 in the city of Mindelo, island of S. Vicente.

The tournament was played in the Swiss system with 5 sessions, one on the 24th and two on each of the

- S. Vicente 17 players from 3 clubs;
- Sal 2 players from 2 clubs;
- Santiago 1 player;
- S. Nicolau 1 player;
- Santo Antão 1 player.

Among these players were the 5

remaining days.

This event, because of the pandemic, was limited to the participation of 30 players, with for reserved seats regional champions and preference for ranked players and female athletes.

The participants were 22 players from 5 islands and representing 8 clubs distributed as follows:

regional champions, who forced each region to hold its regional championships. Participation in these regional championships recorded the following number of participants:

- Regional of S. Vicente: 17;
- Regional Santo Antão:7;
- Regional Sal:38;
- Regional of Santiago:9;

Regional S. Nicolau: 13.

managed to stay in the top 3 and

with access to the finals.

It should be reported that in all rounds, for the first time in Cape Verde, 8 live matches were broadcast on the world's largest chess platforms.



In total, 84 players participated at regional level in the "clearance" for the seats reserved and reimbursed by FCX of this preliminary phase of CNIA 2021.

With sufficient intensity, the preliminary occurred with all normality, having observed all health safety measures.

# FINAL

As support was obtained for this championship, FCX decided, as expected, that it would participate in this competition, which took place from 15 to 22 November, with 10 players saying:

The Champion in title:

Mariano Ortega;



In the end, in the standings, only one of the regional champions

Cape Verde Cup Winner - Éder Pereira;

- The best of the national classification David Mirulla, Célia Rodriguez and António Monteiro;
- The first 5 finalists of the preliminary round Iura Miranda, Gil Teixeira, Bruno Santos, Aires Fortes and Carlos Mőes.

The tournament was played in the Round Robin system (9 rounds), with a daily round, with the exception of the last two days in which there was a need to resort to double rounds.

For the first time, in a tournament held in Cape Verde, all players had Elo FIDE and for the first time the All games were broadcast live on the world's leading chess



platforms.



CNIA had the participation of 10 players.

Only in the last round was it possible to qualify the 2021 Champion, because at the

beginning of this round, Ortega and Mirulla, counted only for victories in the games so far played.

It should be reported that the arbitration was attended by José Rita (STP) who had moved as Advisor to Lewis Ncube, president

of the ACC.

To dedicate the Champion, all other participants and national chess, Closing Ceremony was held in which of Minister the Sport of Cape Verde, the President of the Olympic Committee Daniel Lopes the Institute of Youth and Sport participated. For this Ceremony was also invited by the president

Lewis Ncube,
whose
presence had
been
confirmed
and
reconfirmed
and who at
the last
minute ended

up not traveling, for logistical reasons, according to his justification.

It was in celebration that CNIA 2021 ended the strongest national tournament held so far in Cape Verde.
