3. Summary of Project Outcomes:

The project trained 10 persons trained to teach chess in schools; the federation continue to engage schools that chess have been introduced in with some expansion in the chess in school program. 15 females' chess skills developed through chess training programs; today Liberia can boast of a fielding a female chess team in the 44th FIDE Chess Olympiad. Liberia Chess Federation acquired Chess materials that include electronic clocks, chess boards and few other chess equipment for tournaments and clubs; Liberia currently own electronic boards that besides boosting the moral of Liberian chess, capacitate us to set up and host tournament at high FIDE standard.
