ECHECS CALENDRIER DES ACTIVITÉS POUR 2024

Bon dosage entre tournois locaux et internationaux

La Mauritian Chess Federation (MCF) a choisi des dates qui devraient satisfaire à la fois ceux qui aiment prendre part aux tournois locaux que ceux qui jouent à l'extérieur. La Fédération mauricienne d'échecs a déjà envoyé des représentants au mois de janvier au Zonal 4.4 à Madagascar. Mais cela ne s'arrête pas là. Pour tous ceux qui aiment jouer à l'étranger, d'autres rendez-vous sont prévus cette année.

«UNE des caractéristiques de ce calendrier, c'est qu'il équilibre l'équilibre de l'année internationale, nous dit Patrick Li Ying, vice-président de la MCF. Le premier gros tournoi international – le Commonwealth Chess Championship – une compétition qui comportera 9 rounds – aura lieu du 20 au 28 février à Malé, Maldives. Y participeront le champion de Maurice Karim Anderson (2nd-Mauritan champion sous la MCF), Henrius Ah Kye, Henna Seentpersand et Bruno Tharbach. Trois autres de nos représentants, soit Roman Engret (1-15), Valentin Muncan (1-16), Arnon Seebach (1-17). Plus ceux qui ont été à Maurice se tiendra le premier tournoi local, un blitz, le 24 février.

En mars, deux événements auront lieu. En premier lieu, nous que Stéphane Lam Kaï Cheung, très satisfait de son classement au zonal de janvier, participera au Championship of Malaga individuel à Oviedo, en Espagne, du 12 au 21 mars. A raison de nous que la MCF organisera ici, de 8

des nord-ouest jamaïcains se tiendra à Mexico, au Mexique. Toutefois, la MCF n'a pas encore confirmé sa participation.

En octobre, une FIDE Continental Cup sera organisée par la MCF pour fêter le 100^e anniversaire de cette instance internationale. Trois représentants sont attendus d'ici novembre et novembre. Pour ce faire, nous organisons un tournoi rapide de 2

rounds – fait savoir Patrick Li Ying qui nous informe également que c'est au mois de novembre, du 9 au 24, qu'aura lieu les Masters masculins. Selon le Cap sera organisée par la MCF. Quatre Mauriciens obtiennent le titre de candidats-maitres

Meriza Acham, Manon Berger, Chethannah Andhin et Deniss Ah Kye se sont vu attribuer chacun un titre de candidats-maitres par la Fédération internationale d'échecs (FIDE). Il y a deux ans, de fait, ce titre de sélection mauricienne qui avait été attribué aux olympiades d'échecs en Inde (26 juillet-11 août 2022). Le fait leur a permis de se qualifier pour la sélection internationale. Depuis le 1^{er} janvier, les nouveaux règlements de la FIDE ont permis à ce que ce soit chose faite.

«Par ailleurs, et c'est à nous de nous en rendre compte, il est important que les joueurs aillent dans des compétitions comme les olympiades ou les zonals où ils peuvent avoir des idées nouvelles. Car parfois, pour avoir un titre, il faut participer à trois tournois en Europe. Or, dans les grands tournois internationaux, votre médaille, ou peut-être un titre directement sur une seule performance, assure Patrick Li Ying.

A noter que d'autres Mauriciens ont le même titre dans le pays, à l'instar de Anwarul Haque chez les filles et de Patrick Li Ying, Ronald Rambert, Devanand Channarayn et Joven Koster. Soala Roy Phillips et Andrian Jeter ont un titre plus élevé, à savoir celui de Maître FIDE.

«Le nombre de titres est important. C'est pourquoi il est important que les joueurs aillent dans des compétitions comme les olympiades ou les zonals où ils peuvent avoir des idées nouvelles. Car parfois, pour avoir un titre, il faut participer à trois tournois en Europe. Or, dans les grands tournois internationaux, votre médaille, ou peut-être un titre directement sur une seule performance, assure Patrick Li Ying.

Tananarive – Zonal 4.4 – Tournoi de haut niveau

Au total 44 teams à Madagascar, du 10 au 18 janvier, ce sont Deniss Ah Kye et Stéphane Lam Kaï Cheung qui représenteront Maurice. Au départ, sur 30 joueurs, Deniss Ah Kye était classé 15^e alors que Stéphane Lam Kaï Cheung se trouvait à la 17^e. Après 9 rounds, Stéphane Lam Kaï Cheung est monté à la 1^{re} place en ayant score de 4 points. Quant à Deniss Ah Kye, il est 17^e avec 3,5 points. Le vainqueur, chez les hommes, a été le Malgache (Maître International, 2400 points Elo) Vy Anantiana Rakotonirahona qui a obtenu 8 points sur les 9 rounds joués.

Andhin sur sa lancée en France

Enfin, en France, depuis deux ans, Chethannah Andhin (qui avait bien joué l'an dernier à certaines compétitions internationales) continue à prendre part à des tournois dans l'Hexagone. Au rapide mené du Club d'Échecs International de Toulouse (CEIT) en janvier (5 rounds système suisse, cadence Fischer 15min + 5sec, par coup), la Mauricienne a pris la 9^e place sur 41 participants. Elle en a 1,5 points sur les 5 possibles. Notons que Meriza Acham qui se trouve depuis fin 2023 en Belgique, pour raisons professionnelles, a aussi l'opportunité de s'entraîner dans des clubs belges actuellement.

16 au 24 mars, le Republic Cup 2024. Cela dit, stipulons une nouveauté dans le paysage des échecs le mois suivant. Sachant qu'un mondial sera organisé à Gênes d'Or - du 19 au 21 avril – lors d'un salon du sport et de la détente et des loisirs. Les membres de la MCF auront l'opportunité de promouvoir la discipline auprès du public. Après cela, se tiendra du 1^{er} au 9 juin les Masters Qualifier.

Le mois de juillet sera à l'organisation des 4 meilleurs joueurs dans 3 catégories (U16, U18 et U21) qui auront pris part en décembre 2023 à un Youth Championship au Gymkhana Club. Ils prendront les 4 premiers de chaque catégorie et on va faire un tournoi rapide de 5 rounds, ainsi l'entraîneur (Bhavani, président de la MCF). En août, du 3 au 18, les filles seront les seules à prendre part aux Masters. Notons que le mois de août sera aussi marqué par la tenue des 10^e rencontres internationales des échecs franco-germano au Canada du 10 au 19 août.

Les femmes olympiades auxquelles est convoquée la sélection mauricienne, seront organisées à Budapest, Hongrie et auront lieu du 10 au 23 septembre. La MCF espère que les sélectionnées mauriciennes de bonne performance et notamment d'autres titres, notamment l'entraîneur Bhavani et Patrick Li Ying, puissent à la même période (15-29 septembre).

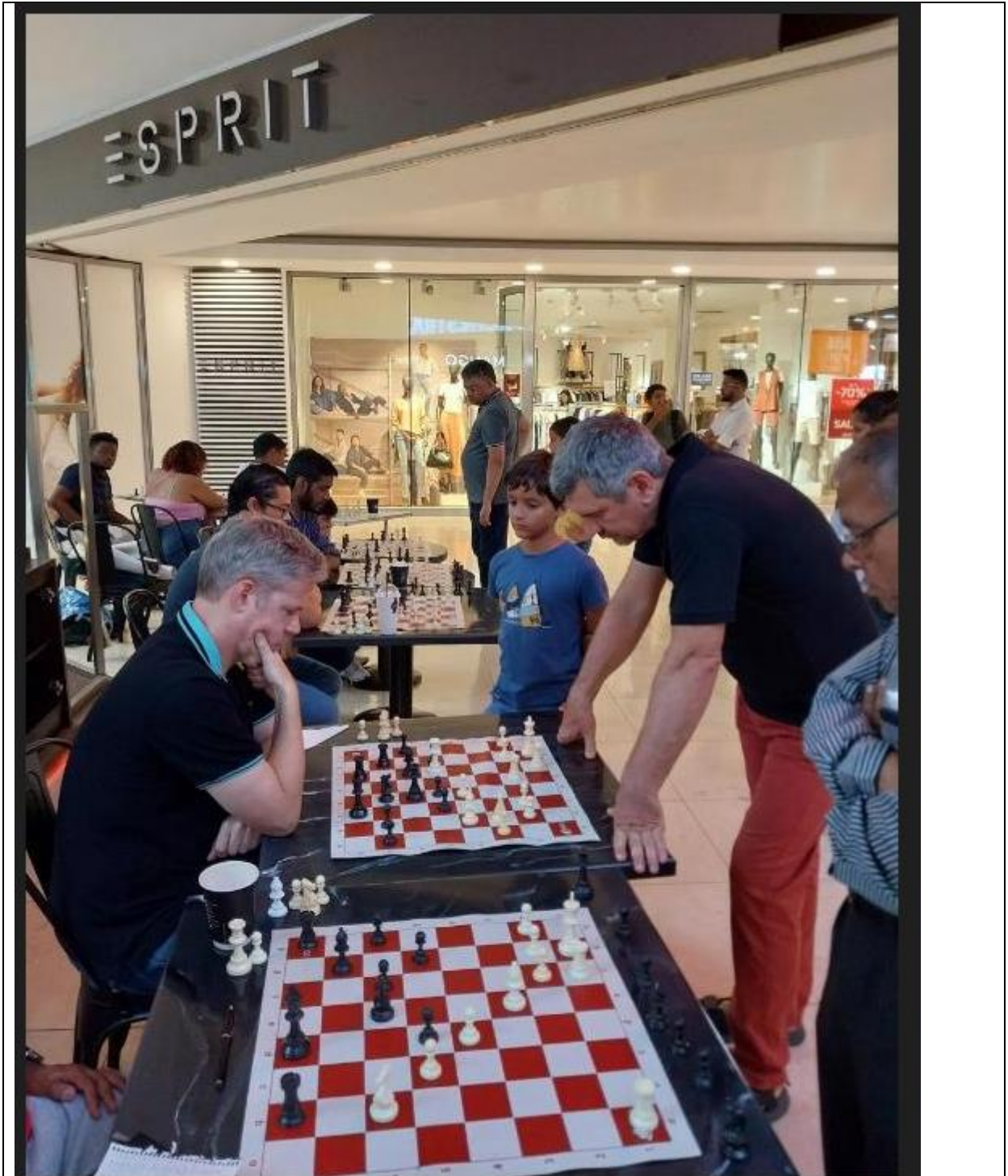



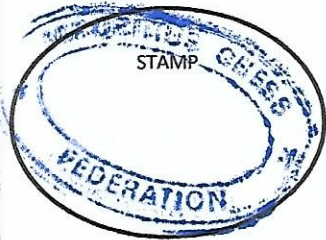
