Oman Chess set for national age-category tourney

The Oman Chess Committee is preparing to organise the Oman Individual Chess Championships for age categories from January 23 to 28. The championship will be held at the Sultan Qaboos Sports Complex, with the participation of 80 players representing various clubs in the Sultanate of Oman.

The championships — includes five age categories: under 8 years, under 10 years, under 12 years, under 14 years and under 16 years. The competition will follow the Swiss system with seven rounds, where each player is allocated 60 minutes, along with a 30-second increment per move.

In a special statement, Ahmed al Kalabi, Chairman of the Oman Chess Committee, highlighted the importance of the championship, saying: — "This championship is one of the most prominent events organised by the committee. Through it, we aim to achieve strategic objectives aimed at developing the game in Oman. Our focus is not only on competition but also on building a generation of qualified players who can represent the Sultanate of Oman in international arenas."

Al Kalabi added: "We have ensured a professional organisational environment that aligns with the standards of the International Chess Federation (Fide) by implementing the Swiss system and adding time increments per move, providing players with a unique experience and an opportunity to learn and grow. Additionally, the chosen age categories form the foundational base for expanding the chess playing community in Oman."

He continued: "The support and cooperation of clubs with the Oman Chess Committee are the cornerstone of the success of such championships. Positive engagement from parents also enhances the players' ability to achieve advanced levels."


Finally, Al Kalabi invited the public and chess enthusiasts to attend the championship and cheer for the young players, emphasising that such support reflects the significance of chess as a mental sport that contributes to developing intellectual and creative skills in youth.

The committee seeks to provide participants with opportunities to obtain international ratings and titles, thereby elevating the status of chess in Oman at both local and international levels.

The Oman Individual Chess Championships for age categories will be held from January 23 to 28 with the participation of 80 players.

Oman chess body honours age-category champions

The Oman Chess Committee (OCC) celebrated the winners of the Oman Individual Chess Championship for Age Categories, held on Saturday, January 23, 2025. A total of 87 players, both male and female, from various clubs across Oman participated in the event.

The award ceremony was attended by Jaber al Balushi, Director of the National Teams Affairs Department at the Sultan Qaboos Sports Complex, from January 23 to 28, 2025. The event's patron, along with Khalid al Wadhvani, an OCC member, other committee members, and parents of the players. The championship was conducted in a seven-round Swiss system format, with each player given 60 minutes and an additional 30 seconds per move.

In the various age categories, participants achieved outstanding results. In the Under-8 category, Zaid al Musallam from Salalah Club claimed first place, winning the championship trophy and the gold medal. Anas al Lanki from Muscat Club secured second place and the silver medal, while Ahmed al Jabri from Nakhal Club took third place with the bronze medal. In the Under-10 category, Ayman al Riyami from Salalah Club won first place and the championship trophy along with the gold medal. Yousef al Maswari from Muscat Club secured second place with the silver medal and Anas al Balushi, also from Muscat Club, took third place with the bronze medal.

In the Under-12 category, Ayman al Riyami from Oman Club claimed first place, earning the championship trophy and the gold medal. Ryan al Hind from Salalah Club came in second, winning the silver medal, while Shabab al Jabri from Nakhal Club finished third with the bronze medal.

In the Under-14 category, Ahmed al Balushi from Muscat Club secured first place, winning the championship trophy and the gold medal. Al Musallam al Baki from Salalah Club came in second, earning the silver medal, while Anwar al Maswari from Muscat Club finished third with the bronze medal.

In the Under-16 category, Wadiah al Saei from Muscat Club claimed first place, earning the championship trophy and the gold medal, while Mohammed al Riyami from Nakhal Club came in second.

Musallam al Wadhvani expressed his happiness with the success of the Oman Individual Chess Championship for Age Categories, highlighting the wide participation and competitive level displayed by the players.

He added, "We are proud of the objectives achieved by this Championship, as it has contributed to discovering promising young talents in chess. We look forward to supporting and developing their skills to represent Oman in international arenas. We also value the

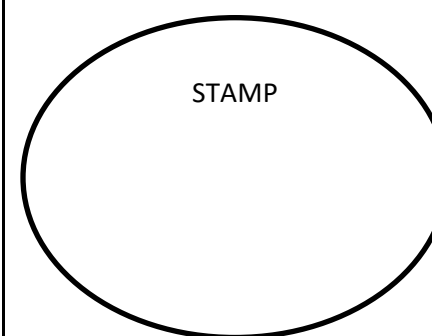
